- **3.** Hasland Goal Posts/Nets Although currently out of stock at Quickplay Ltd, we are going to purchase mobile Goal posts (One off initially to trial), to hopefully replace the current Traffic cones topped with corner flags.
- **4. Walking Football World Cup** Thanks to more than 30 members who have offered their help over the weekend of 17<sup>th</sup> May. We are still to hold our first meeting with the Community Trust to establish our roles, but a World Cup sub-Committee is now in place. Thanks to Charlie Last, Pete Jacques, Rob Church & Phil O'Gorman who have agreed to help organize our Group of volunteers.

- **5. Staying with The World Cup.** Friendlies at 4 age levels (50s, 60s, 65s & 70's) are being finalized against The Australian national squad 'The Walkeroos'. This has been arranged for Tuesday afternoon 14<sup>th</sup> May at Queens Park 1pm 3pm.

Now here's the tough bit in relation to selecting players for the friendly games against Australia We have 111 members with varying skill and fitness levels, and with squads of 9 players, the most that will get any playing time is 45 members. - 7. Now the 'possibly' better news Hopefully, this isn't the end of playing opportunities. The Walkeroos have already booked Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May at Queens Park 11am 1pm. I think they will want us there again. (But can't be sure just yet). If this is the case, I'll ask the Captain's to keep a 'core' of possibly 4 key players, and we will then give priority to those who are not involved on Tuesday.

Also, Keith Jackson from the Community Trust informed me a few weeks ago, that the Polish teams may well ask for warm up games as well.

Colours for World Cup week – For those involved in and around the Stadium over the weekend, we have been asked to wear either our blue Senior Spireites football shirts, our blue Senior Spireites rain jackets, or the old blue zipped jackets (Mansfield Building Society). This is so we can be recognized as Helpers. Yellow bibs maybe required Pitch side.

For the games against the Aussies, it will be our individual blue Senior Spireites shirts, blue or white shorts, blue or white socks and yellow bibs.

**9. New Kit Orders –** Ordering new kit (clothing) in bulk once a year, is the most cost effective and least time consuming for those involved in the ordering process.

In recent weeks we have purchased several items in 'dribs & drabs' and we really wanted to conclude our purchasing activity for the foreseeable future. However, in light of our World Cup involvement and several new members joining, we will have one final round of ordering Rain Jackets and Club Football shirts.

I would like the request process to be completed by the end of March, thus allowing April delivery, in time for May.

For Shirts, contact Ian Edmundson <a href="mailto:ianed@live.co.uk">ianed@live.co.uk</a> – These are priced at £12 for short sleeved, & £14 for long sleeved. Sizes are M, L, XL and 2XL.

If you haven't got any of the above and don't want to purchase one, I don't think there would be a problem in asking another member who owns one to borrow it for a couple of days!!
